

Driver safety, confidence, and comfort are enhanced by utilizing the most up-to-date research in the field, including the latest visual scanning and steering techniques, anti-lock braking (ABS) skills, airbag information, driver distraction, road rage and new vehicle technology.

The 4 Hr. Refresher course is \$20 and the 8 hour full course is \$24. Persons age 55 and older who complete the course qualify for a ten percent discount on their auto insurance premiums for three years, according to Minnesota law. SACRED HEART PASTORAL COUNCIL SUMMARY JANUARY 29, 2010

OLD BUSINESS: The hand sanitizer suggested at the last meeting has been put in place for use by the Ministers of Communion and is being used. The landscaping project is still being studied; confessional updating on hold for new pastor.

Parish Manager Report—The bus is being stored and a letter (which the diocese needs to approve) is being drawn up for Sacred Heart to give the bus back to Father Mark. The upper part of the rectory is in order; the lower part still needs some work. Things need to be gone through and possibly some painting done. Hopefully between the Knights and CCW, this can be tackled. We are hoping to have at least one service between the two parishes on Ash Wednesday. Confirmation will be in Hackensack on Saturday, March 20th at 4 p.m.. The Sacramental records are caught up and the envelope inputting, as well. The Walker financial statements are finished and the Sacred Heart ones are being worked on.

It was reported that the Homebound Ministry is going well. There are now 5 Ministers of Communion taking turns in calling on Sacred Heart residents at the Senior Class as well as other homebound members.

NEW BUSINESS: Veryl Rothering—a long-time member of Sacred Heart who passed away recently—willed his property of house and 28 acres to Sacred Heart. The legal transfer of the property is in process. The council feels and has had feedback that Anna and Jennifer are doing a great job as co-coordinators of the Youth Education/Ministry program. There will be ecumenical services in Hackensack with our involvement. Don Rudquist is co-coordinating.
