## **DRE REPORT**

There is one release time class left. Problems with the students running to and from school, along with respect issues in class, continue. The Board discussed the possibility of implementing a Behavior Expectation Policy next year to address these issues. Anna will check with Chad at Hope Lutheran to see what their policy is.

First Communion and First Reconciliation classes will begin March 3<sup>rd</sup>. Six classes consisting of 2 lessons per class are scheduled during the Diving Deeper time slot. These classes will include the Diocese requirement of a parent/student lesson and a retreat attended by a parent and student. The retreat day will be held at St. Agnes on April 24<sup>th</sup> from 9-2pm and will include the final two lessons, making bread, and receiving the sacrament of 1<sup>st</sup> Reconciliation. First Communion will be Sunday April 25<sup>th</sup> at St. Agnes. A letter and registration will be mailed out to the appropriate students, along with Anna being available at all Masses this weekend for personal registration. Pete will check with the Diocese as to how to address any students who may not complete the requirements.

Youth Ministry Nights are growing and the last attendance was up to 5 jr. high/high school students.

The Youth group is taking the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of Lent to present the Stations of the Cross at St. Agnes.

Eight Students are scheduled to be confirmed on March 20<sup>th</sup>. Several workable dates were given by the Bishop and the students agreed on the 20<sup>th</sup> of March. The Bishop also requested the earlier Mass time (Hackensack) due to travel issues.

## **FAITH FORMATION**
